

Admissions Interview Questions

Directions: Create a minimum of five questions to ask the college admissions counselor about the college and the education program. Questions that are more specific to the education program might be best answered by the program of study counselor. The admissions counselor should be able to direct you to the correct person to answer your questions. The questions are to determine if the college is the right fit for you.

Sample questions might include (but are not limited to):

1. What is the professor to student ratio?
2. What are classes structured like (lecture, hands-on, field experience)?
3. What scholarships are available for education students?
4. What externship and internships opportunities does the college/university offer?
5. Are there opportunities for education students to study abroad?

After you have formulated the questions, conduct the interview via e-mail, in person, Skype or Google Hangouts. Allow plenty of time for discussion for each question. Some questions may require a follow-up question that may arise from the answers to original questions asked.
