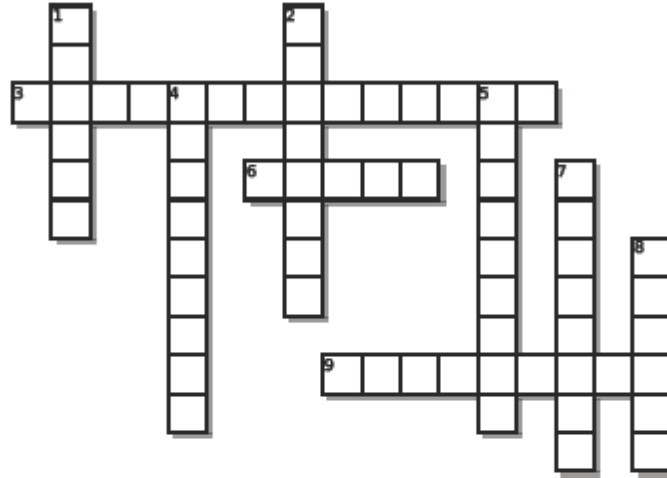


What Happens Before Birth?

Prenatal Development



ACROSS

- 3 earliest age when the fetus can survive if born prematurely; occurs between 22 and 26 weeks
- 6 prenatal organism from ninth week to end of pregnancy
- 9 three equal time periods in prenatal development, each lasting three months

DOWN

- 1 newly fertilized cell at conception
- 2 organ that surrounds the embryo and permits the exchange of nutrients and waste products between the mother and embryo
- 4 helps prevent premature birth and neural tube defects
- 5 drug or other substance capable of interfering with the development of an embryo fetus that may lead to birth defects or developmental malformations
- 7 before birth
- 8 prenatal organism from 2 to 8 weeks after conception
